Tasks and responsibilities

- Testing of all equipment.
- Ensuring the assembly, testing and repairs are done in accordance with the standard procedures (IMCA, WOD-SOE, IRATA and Bluestream quality standards).
- Compliance with relevant health and safety policy(s).
- Report as necessary on changes in standards (internally and externally initiated) and on performances against standards.
- Ensuring that any changes to equipment or systems are fully authorised, supported by drawings and technical documentation in accordance with the engineering procedures.
- Working with subcontractors on systems.
- Mobilisation and demobilisation of the equipment and units locally and overseas.
- Support in any other activities when needed.

Preferred qualifications

- Intermediate technical education in pneumatic/hydraulic/electrical engineering level.
- Strong desire to work in the offshore industry.
- Good knowledge of (high voltage) electrical safe working practices.
- Experience in troubleshooting electrical equipment and associated software.
- Experience in troubleshooting mechanical, hydraulic and pneumatic systems.
- Ability to read electrical/mechanical/hydraulic line drawings.
- At least 1-3 years of relevant working experience in a similar position.
- Good command of the Dutch and English language; spoken and written
- Experience in the offshore industry, whilst desirable, is not a pre-requisite to this position.
- SSC (VCA) certified.
- Responsible for compliance with SCC (VCA) and ISO standards.
